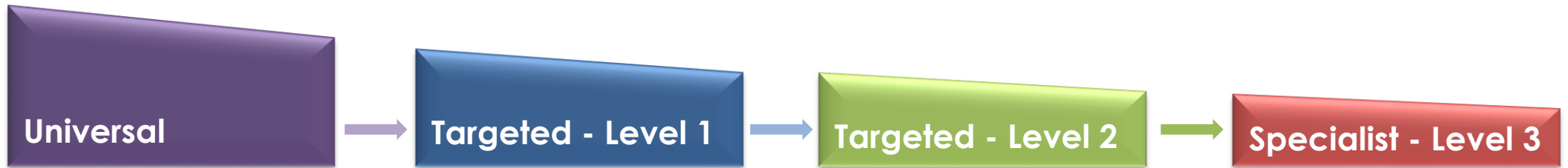


Levels of Support



Child or young person can access universal services with minimal support

Open to all families with disabled children, universal services are available to the general public. Any child or young person with a disability can access provision with the same level of support as any other child/young person.

Example of universal services

- Youth Clubs
- Children's centres
- After school clubs
- Sports clubs
- Leisure and play activities
- Brownies, Scouts, Beavers

Child or young person who cannot access universal services alone

These services are provided to disabled children and young people who have additional needs that cannot be met by universal services. **These services can be accessed directly by the parent/carer.**

Child or young person who requires a higher level of support

These services are provided to children and young people who require a higher level of support to access short break activities and meet the Eligibility Criteria as described on page 5.. **These services can be accessed by self-referral or via a Lead Professional.**

Child or young person requiring services identified through a social care assessment

These services are provided in addition to Targeted Levels 1 and 2 services where needs are identified through a social care assessment and meet the threshold for additional support.

Specialist services

- Care and support within the home and outside the home
- Overnight Short Breaks
- Care in the home of an approved carer
- Direct Payments/Pre-paid card
